Coach Information

We recruit all of our top quality rugby coaches from the Southern Hemisphere. Many of our coaches from previous years will be returning, in some cases for their fourth summer with us and with lots more new names coming on board we are certain our 2009 programme will be a great success. Our coaches gallery has previously included such talent as Peter Schuster (Samoan national team head coach/manager), Ian Doust (All Black under 19 trainer), Sirelli Bulicokocoko (Fijian 7's coach during their Hong Kong win of 2005) and John Akurangi (Leicester Tigers & Stade Francais forward). Each of our courses is headed up by a coach with a similar level of experience as these professionals and brings with them their nations own distinct philosophy and approach to the game. All of our coaches are CRB (police record) checked in their own country before coming to the UK and upon arrival they also attend a Child Protection workshop run by Sports Coach UK. Course Information

A Socius Sports Rugby Course gives your child the opportunity to be taught by some of the best Rugby Union coaches the Southern Hemisphere has to offer. It's an experience that can inspire & influence them throughout their sporting lives.

Each day is divided into short lessons to keep each participant focussed and progressing through the lessons as quickly and effectively as possible. There are lots of short breaks built into each day giving players the opportunity to quiz their coach on any aspect of the coaching with Q&A sessions to ensure each skill is fully understood, not just the practise but the theory behind the lesson too.

Each player attending the course will receive their own Socius Sports All Element training ball, sports bag and gift pack.

In addition to this, each camp that has a Kiwi coach will be given the opportunity to learn the NZ Haka (some Aussies also teach their version of the Haka - (Where's Me Wallet?) - a performance of which will be given on the Friday afternoon at the end of the course.
